Promoter Details

The Promoter (“**We**”) is Western Australian Gould League (ABN 99 685 184 006) of Cnr Flynn and Selby St, Wembley WA 6014, Australia. The Promoter is also known as WA Gould League or WAGL.

Entering the Competition

Who can enter

The design competition (the "**Competition**") is open to children living in Western Australia aged between five and seventeen years old ("**You**").

Entrants must have a parent or guardian’s consent to enter, and further such parent or guardian must read and consent to these Conditions of Entry.

Employees or agents of WA Gould League or their immediate family members are not eligible to enter the Competition.

How to enter

The competition commences on **Tuesday 3rd March at 12:01 AM (AWST)** and concludes on **Friday 26th June at 11:59 PM (AWST)** (the “Competition Period”).

We must receive your entry to the Competition by **Friday 26th June at 11:59 PM (AWST)**. Late entries will not be accepted.

To enter the Competition, You must submit a completed design (drawing or painting) of a native Western Australian fauna or flora species.

The entry must be:

1. the original independent creation of the entrant. Copies of pre-existing images, whether visually replicated or traced, are not acceptable. Colouring an outline created by someone else or receiving external assistance in creating the artwork is also prohibited.
2. created using any traditional or digital media, including but not limited to pen, pencil, acrylics, watercolour, mixed media, collage or created with the use of digital painting software. No photography, videos, 3D sculptures or AI-generated work will be accepted.
 - a. The use of artificial intelligence (AI) tools or software in the creation of artworks is strictly prohibited. Any artwork found to have been created, in whole or in part, using AI will be automatically disqualified from the competition. All submitted artworks may be screened using AI-detection software as part of our review and integrity processes to identify and monitor potential AI-generated content.
3. free from any claims, including but not restricted to copyright or trademark claims, by other parties.
4. submitted via a high-resolution image upload but no larger than 5 MB in size. Image must not include any text or other background information. All entries must be submitted digitally, as physical entries will not be accepted.
5. made specifically for this competition. Entries must have been made after 2 March 2026.
6. Image files must follow a naming convention of: 'Age_EntrantName_SpeciesName', e.g. *12_JaneDoe_CygnusAtratus*

To enter the Competition, You must submit your entry online through the WA Gould League's website competition form or by email to admin@wagouldleague.com.au.

Entrants are limited to two (2) entries per person, throughout the competition period. These must be submitted separately.

When submitting your Competition entry, You must provide your name, age, suburb and the name and contact telephone number and email address of your parent or guardian. We will only use this information in relation to the Competition (including checking your eligibility to enter it) and will not use it for any other purposes whatsoever. We will not keep this information for longer than is necessary for the operation of the Competition and affiliated exhibition awareness.

It is a condition of entry that all prize Winners agree to have their name, age, photo and artwork design published for publicity purposes if required. By participating in this Competition, participants signify their acceptance of all conditions and the requirement to participate in promotional activity if required.

There is no entry fee to enter the Competition.

The Prizes

There will be six (6) prize winners of the Competition (“**Winner**”). Each winner will receive a WAGL Family Friends Membership (“**Prize**”) to the value of \$70 AUD (including GST).

Additionally, a \$50 AUD prize (“**People’s Choice Prize**”) will be awarded to the People's Choice Winner, determined by public voting through our exhibition. This prize will be a \$50 gift voucher to use in the Herdsman Lake Discovery Gift Shop with a 3 year expiry.

The total prize pool is valued at up to RRP \$470.00 AUD (including GST). The Promoter accepts no responsibility for the change in the Prize specification or value between now and the ultimate redemption date.

The prizes will need to be collected by the winners by Friday 31st July 2026. Any prizes left unclaimed are forfeited. Where the Winner is already a WAGL Friends Member they can choose the activation date of the Prize to begin on a date after their current membership ends, but before 1 July 2027.

The prizes cannot be exchanged or transferred by You and cannot be redeemed by You for cash or any other prizes.

Picking the winners

The Competition is a game of skill, and chance plays no part in determining the Winners.

A panel of WA Gould League staff members will choose the six (6) winning entries for the Competition. The winning entries will be those considered to be the most visually interesting and technically skillful.

The judges' decision will be made by Monday 13th July. The decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Individual feedback on artworks cannot be provided due to the volume of entries. Requests for feedback will not receive a response.

The People's Choice Winner will be determined by the total number of public paper votes received during the exhibition period. Each individual may cast one vote. The People's Choice Winner will be announced alongside the other prize winners. In the event of joint winners, the prize money will be evenly divided among the winners.

The parents or guardians of the winners will be notified by email on or before Monday 13th July.

Publishing the winning entries

The winning entries will be announced on the WA Gould League's social channels (Facebook and Instagram) from Monday 13th July or (if WAGL needs to delay this announcement for any reason) at a later date.

WA Gould League owns the copyright to your Competition entry upon submission, however, must always credit the submitter as its author.

By submitting an entry to the Competition, You give WAGL:

1. Permission for your entry to be published on their social media and grant WAGL a non-exclusive, royalty-free, worldwide license to republish your Competition entry in electronic format and hard copy for purposes connected with the Competition and affiliated exhibition promotion; and
2. The right to use your name and age for the sole purpose of identifying You as the author of your entry.

Some other rules

Entries on behalf of another person will not be accepted and joint submissions are not allowed.

We take no responsibility for entries that are lost, delayed, misdirected or incomplete or cannot be delivered or entered for any technical or other reason. Proof of delivery of the entry is not proof of receipt.

WAGL accepts no responsibility for any damage, loss, liabilities, injury or disappointment incurred or suffered by You as a result of entering the Competition or accepting the prize. WAGL further disclaims liability for any injury or damage to You or any other person's computer relating to or resulting from participation in or downloading any materials in connection with the Competition.

WAGL reserves the right at any time and from time to time to modify or discontinue, temporarily or permanently, this Competition with or without prior notice due to reasons outside its control (including, without limitation, in the case of anticipated, suspected or actual fraud). The decision of WAGL in all matters under its control is final and binding.

The Competition will be governed by Australian law.
